

## Want access to rapid COVID-19 testing?

Now Scheme members can access antigen tests (and more) at conveniently located drive-through facilities.

"That's why we've introduced the option to access rapid antigen testing for COVID-19 she adds.

Antigen tests (also called Rapid Point of Care Tests) can, within 60 minutes, detect whether a person has contracted COVID-19.

This is particularly important in the context of the third wave of COVID-19 infection that our country is currently experiencing. Quick access to testing is critical to identifying people who have contracted the disease and directing them to self-isolate and focus on their healthcare needs while preventing the spread of infection to others.

### Antigen testing network providers

Scheme members can access antigen testing at one of our network providers:

- PathCare, when referred by the doctor who screened you
- Dischem pharmacies

### Drive-through testing locations

Scheme members will be able to access antigen testing at:

Once at the drive through locations, an administrator will assist you with registering online, completing the screening questionnaire and filling in your personal details. Thereafter, a Healthcare Professional will take a swab from your nose which will be sent for analysis. You need not wait for results as these will be sent to you via SMS.

### **What do antigen tests cost?**

- Antigen tests cost R390 each.

### **Do my medical scheme benefits cover the costs?**

- Scheme members have access to two COVID-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) and two rapid antigen tests per beneficiary per annum, as part of the screening benefit of the WHO Global Outbreak Benefit. If you use a provider outside of the network, or you have already used the available two tests in the benefit, you will have to pay for the test.

### **What happens once I receive my antigen test results?**

- If your antigen test is positive, you will receive a call from the doctor who referred you for the test, if you were screened by the pharmacy nurse then please ensure you call your doctor to discuss next steps.
- Should you have symptoms of COVID-19 but receive a negative antigen test result, you will be directed to have a PCR test (\*see details below) to verify your results

## **COVID RAPID ANTIBODY TESTING**

These tests are:

- Also called Rapid Point of Care tests
- Useful in identifying people who have already had a COVID-19 infection and may no longer be infectious
- NOT used to diagnose an active (current) COVID-19 infection
- Analyse a drop of blood from a finger prick
- Provide results within 60 minutes.

## **COVID \*PCR TESTING**

\*These tests are:

- Commonly referred to as PCR or RT-PCR tests
- Considered the gold-standard in COVID-19 and the most sensitive type of test we have access to (high chance of picking up an infection)
- Recommended for people who have symptoms of COVID-19, travellers and patients requiring hospital admission
- Carried out on a sample taken by swabbing the nose or throat (done by a healthcare professional) and sent to a pathology lab (e.g. but not limited to PathCare, Lancet, Ampath, Vermaak) to analyse.
- Results are available within 24 hours.
