Defining Dentistry Treatments

What is **preventative** and basic dentistry?

Drilling, filling, extractions, cleaning, root canal and routine check-ups.

What is **advanced** dentistry?

Maxillofacial surgery, implants or crowns, wisdom extracts, inlays, bridgework, orthodontics, making and repairing dentures, periodontics and osseo-integrated implants.

What is **orthodontics**?

Subject to orthodontic quotation and prior approval from Scheme, this is the branch of dentistry dealing with the prevention and correction of irregular teeth, by means of braces.

What is **maxillofacial** and oral surgery?

Oral and maxillofacial surgery specialises in treating many diseases, injuries and defects in the head, neck, face, jaws and the hard and soft tissues of the oral (mouth) and maxillofacial (jaws and face) areas.

What is **other** dental services?

These are dental services that do not fall within the above mentioned categories, such as x-rays.
